Introduction of the letter k. children showed enthusiasm in learning the words and phonics. They repeated along with their teacher and enjoyed the fun way of learning.

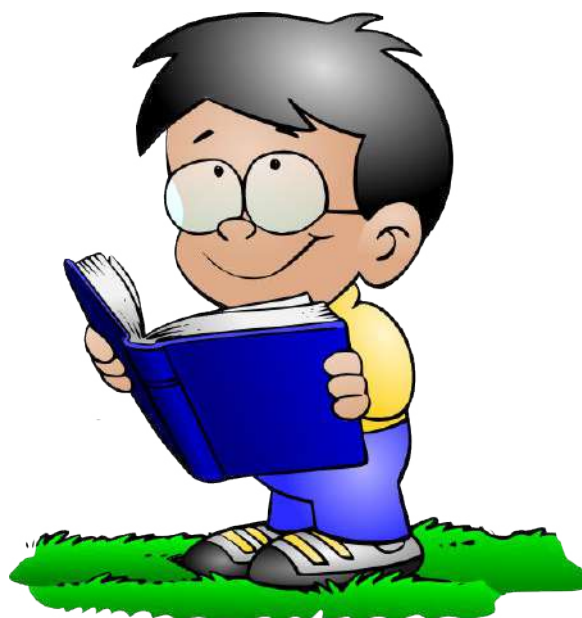

GREEN COLOUR DAY CELEBRATION

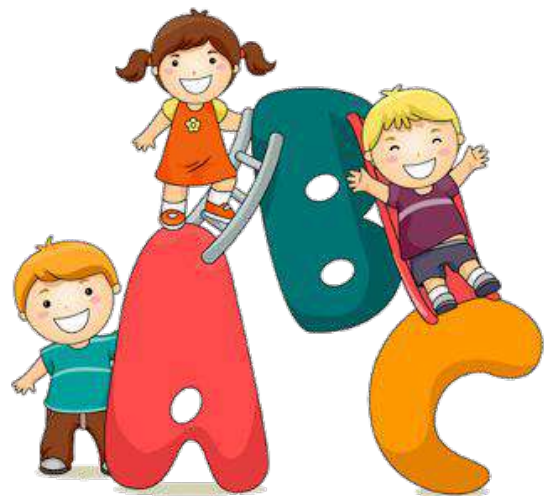

SOCIAL WEEK CELEBRATIONS, 14-08-2018



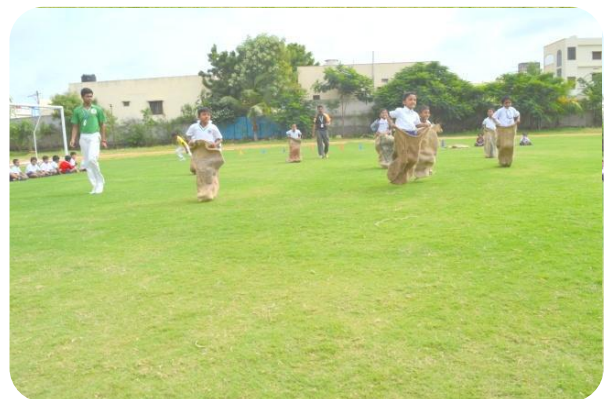

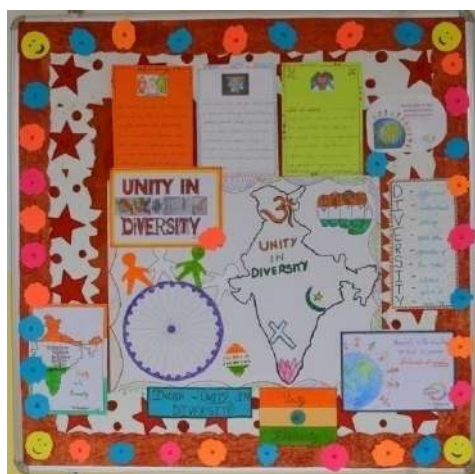
Pallavians have proved their talent once again by bagging prizes in various inter school literary competitions held at Global Indian International School, Uppal campus.
