PRAGATHI-2K19

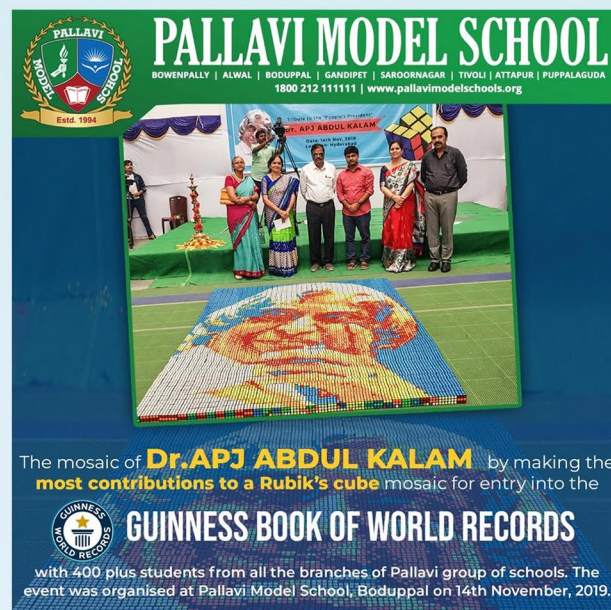

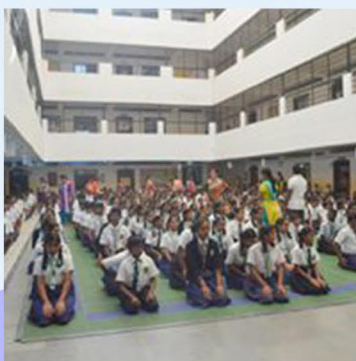
Cbse Science Exhibition

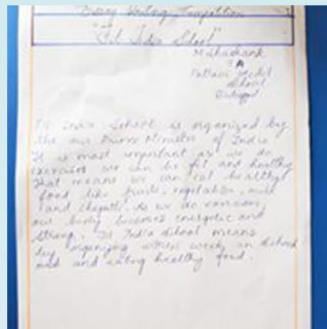


Day 04 - Physical Activities & Essay and Poem Writing Competitions
