Father's Day Celebrations

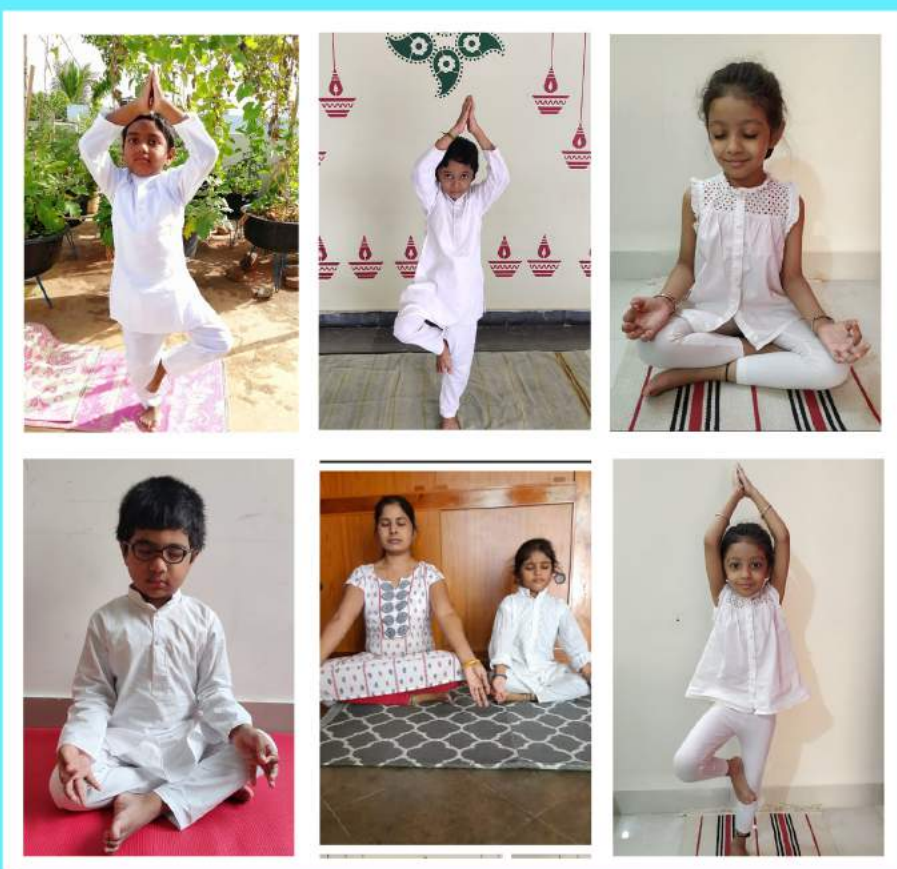
The trend is set Fathers are the role models to their children. The children showcased their love and affection in a small way but with big hearts . Happy Father's Day.

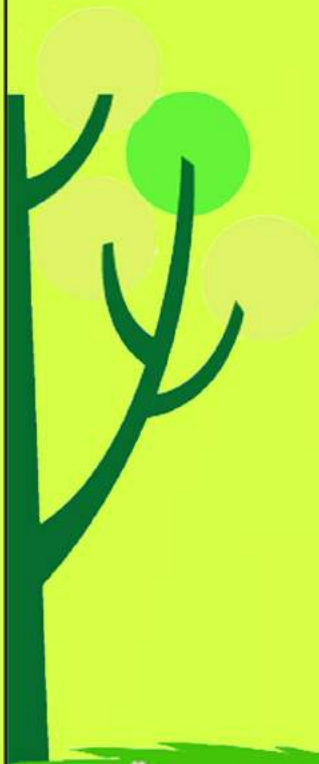

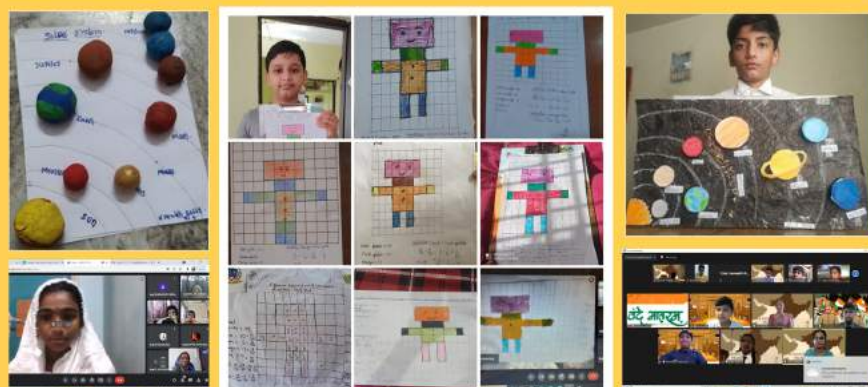
DIY Scientific Toy Making Competition

DOWN THE MEMORY LANE

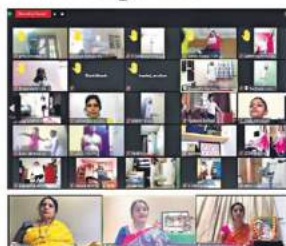


Sometimes, memories are those which you think will make u laugh and smile
