From Principal's desk




On listening to the elephant, the rat king took his entire group of mice and they cut open the nets which trapped the elephant herd. So the elephant herd was totally set free.






Yogaha chitha nivruthihi




Life becomes a musical concert when we dance to the music of nature.


Fit parents


Inter-School Art and Craft Competition






Virtual tour to National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC)ISRO

Students were amazed to see the 2D and 3D satellite images and understood the importance and applications of remote sensing satellites in diverse fields useful for mankind.








Learning math made fun





